At a league review meeting last month, we agreed that our league has been very successful for 5 years now and for the most part our league rules have been pretty solid. We did make a few changes for 2017 and added some clarifications. The high-level list of changes includes the following and are detailed in our [updated league rules](#):

- Boater incentive – new for 2017
- Auto Signup is ok.
- Fowler Lake added to the list of lakes.
- Family pairings are allowed.
- Fishing alone clarifications defined.
- Fishing 3 to a boat netter option defined.
- Live bait is allowed with a 1-rod restriction
- Lure of the week chosen by participants.
- NON-lure-of-the-week big fish bonus scoring added for the catcher.
- Netter points always 5 points (no bonus points).
- Participation points remain the same.
- Inch points for catcher & netter remain the same.
- Boater and Non-boater suggestion list added.

Scoring Tool: An [updated scoring tool](#) has been added to [our league webpage](#) that takes into consideration the scoring changes introduced this year. Please check it out to see how the updated scoring works. We may produce a scoring chart for all fish sizes and scenarios so check back on our website.

IMPORTANT: If you intend to participate for any given week, you must call, text, or email our League Commissioner, Pat Ryan, by 8:00pm on the Monday prior to the league night for that week and indicate if you will be participating as a "Boater" (using your boat) or a "Non-Boater". Pairings will be announced by 8:00pm on Tuesday.

We hope you will give thoughtful consideration to participating with us in this year's spring league **even if you're only able to get out and fish with us just once**. We have a lot of fun together and it's your participation that adds to the fun.

Okauchee Lake 2017 Spring Musky Stocking

The success of our yearling muskies stocking last year was so great that we just had to do it again! So on Thursday, April 20, 2017, 750 yearling muskies were stocked into Okauchee Lake at a cost of \$13 each for a total project cost of \$9750.

More than half of the funding for this project came from another partnership with our Muskellunge Club of Wisconsin (MCW) and the Milwaukee Chapter of Muskies Inc (MCMI). Also, we were awarded a grant from Waukesha County in the unexpectedly generous amount of \$4569.81 that was applied to this project.

This stocking event included onsite support from lots of MCW members, MCMI members, and other muskie fishing friends. Ben Heussner, Wisconsin DNR Fisheries Biologist, and his crew had prepared a 22' x 6' holding pen next to the pier at the Okauchee Lake public boat launch so when Gollon Bait and Fish Farm's stocking truck arrived, the driver unloaded the muskies one net-full at a time with the help from many volunteers who dumped the muskies from each net into the holding pen. This pen allowed the muskies to acclimate to the water in Okauchee Lake before distribution.

Once the truck was unloaded, the muskies were netted from the holding pen and placed into livewells and coolers in the 10 volunteer boats that were on hand. From there our volunteers transported the muskies they had on board to various locations on Okauchee Lake where they were distributed into the lake.

Our muskie stocking supplier, Gollon Bait and Fish Farm from Dodgeville, WI over-wintered muskies and had some available for us again this spring. Back in mid-March our MCW/MCMI stocking committee (MCW: Scott Wilkie & Dave Dawson; MCMI: Brian Mirek & Greg Sieren) met to discuss our plans for this spring. Both clubs had a good year of fundraising in 2016 and early 2017 and were prepared to go big if our supplier had muskie stocking inventory for us.

In [our last MCW Release](#), we announced that we intended to stock both Okauchee and Lac La Belle, but the number of available fish is a big unknown until Gollon harvests their ponds. We learned the numbers for our order a couple days before we stocked and with a few less muskies than originally requested headed our way, we chose to target as many as we could for Okauchee Lake so Lac La Belle didn't get stocked directly this time.

Sidebar: MCMI lead a separately funded Pewaukee Lake muskie stocking that same day with additional funds from John Laimon's 3 Charlies muskie tournament. 254 yearling muskies from the same batch went into Pewaukee Lake that same day.

In addition to having many members from both clubs and other supporters on hand, we were honored to have our Waukesha County Executive, Paul Farrow as well as Lake Country Now reporter, Todd Ponath, share in the yearling muskie stocking we did that day. It's nice to be recognized and much of that recognition is a direct result of the hard work and volunteer efforts of members from both local muskie clubs and those that support us.

Did You Know...

Between 2005 and today (2017), MCW and the Milwaukee Chapter of Muskies Inc partnered for 6 muskie stocking projects on 3 different local lakes (Okauchee, Lac La Belle, and Pewaukee). Together, we stocked a total of 3927 muskies at a cost of \$45,534! That's an average of \$11.60 per muskie. \$6549.81 in Waukesha County grant funding was used for two of these muskie stocking projects. (See [stocking data](#))

Random Thoughts About MCW/MCMI Stocking

- MCW/MCMI Participation:** On April 20, 2017, the following MCW and MCMI members stocked muskies on Okauchee Lake: Greg Rubin (boat), Barry Wichmann, Chuck Montgomery (boat), Phil Grubisic, Mike Phelps (boat), Greg Sieren, Reily Sieren, Charlie Sieren, Rich Garner (boat), Mike Wyszowski, Scott Wilkie, Chris Terry (boat), Quinn Terry, Shannon Terry, Thomas Murphy (boat), Dave Dawson (boat), Adam Teriaca, Lauri Teriaca, Brian Mirek (boat), Mark Krmpotich, Mike Malaczewski and Colin Pluta from Musky Magnet Lures plus MCMI guest, Jeff Widmann from Team Rhino Outdoors. Jeff and Colin both did independent Facebook Live posts during the distribution of the muskies. Roxanne Baumann had an early commitment that day but did arrive in time to scoop a few muskies from the holding pen.
- More Participation:** In addition, the following Okauchee Fishing Club members were there with their boats to help stock muskies: Jim Dabish (boat), Ken Mahuta (boat). Wauksha County Executive, Paul Farrow, rode along with Ken and help distribute muskies. While he might not admit it, I'm pretty sure Paul was pretty cold by the time he got back to the dock because he wasn't wearing a jacket. ☺
- DNR Partnership:** Ben Heussner, WDNR Fisheries Biologist and his crew, Kyle Olson and Gus Gospodarek, were there with their net pen and boat, too.
- No Natural Reproduction:** While muskies in our local lakes go through the motions of spawning, studies have shown no successful natural reproduction for muskies occurs here so our muskie populations are sustained completely by stocking. With that said, our annual stocking efforts supplement the DNR's stocking, both of which are very important to maintain a fishable population of muskies here.
- Spring Stocking Opportunity:** Spring yearling muskie stocking rarely occurs because of the extra cost and risk of overwintering young muskies. Gollon Bait and Fish Farm had an incredible year of recruitment with the 2015 year class and contacted us in the late fall of 2015 to ask if we were interested in stocking yearling muskies in the spring of 2016. We jumped at the chance even though the cost was a little more. It was \$13 per yearling muskie instead of the \$10.50 we had been paying them for fall fingerlings.
- Spring Stocking Benefits:** Studies have shown better survival rates for spring-stocked yearling muskies compared to fall-stocked fingerlings. Logic would suggest that the chance for survival of stocking any fish in fall has got to be low because all larger game fish are feeding heavily in fall so those 8-12" meal-size fall stocked muskies are likely very vulnerable. On the other hand, spring-stocked muskies, are a little bigger (13-17") and are going into the lake at a time when they can familiarize themselves with their new surroundings with much less risk of being eaten since bigger game fish are going through spawning and are not feeding very much until they're done and the water starts to warm. By then all kinds of bugs and fish are hatching so there's plenty of food for the yearling muskies and they should have time to find cover. (Together our clubs stocked 1090 yearling muskies into Okauchee Lake in spring 2016.)
- MCW/MCMI Partnership:** MCW and MCMI haven't always worked together the way we do today. In fact, some of our most tenured club members talk as if our clubs were at odds with one another years ago. We now recognize that while each club operates independently, has their own agenda, and does things their own way, stocking is one area where we can work together to make a greater impact than either club can do on their own. And that is great news for all who fish for muskies in our region regardless if they are members of either club or not.
- Clubs Memberships:** This isn't stocking related, but is worth pointing out. In the past few years, several people have joined both local muskie clubs which is fantastic because it offers more opportunities for muskie related activities. Both clubs have a full calendar of fun on-the-water activities. If you like muskies, are living and/or fishing in southeastern Wisconsin, and you are not a club member yet, consider checking out either club (or both).
- DNR Stocking Database:** The Wisconsin DNR has a very interesting [database of stocking information](#) that you can reference from your computer or mobile device. You can spend lots of time researching different lakes you might be interested in. Interestingly, this database contains only DNR stocking data. It does not contain any private stocking data such as the stocking we do as clubs.

Alliance Raffle Tickets

As stated in the last newsletter, we have asked our members to sell some *Musky Clubs Alliance of Wisconsin* raffle tickets again this year. And many members have already sold all the tickets they've been given – some have even requested more tickets to sell! Thanks to all who are getting active and raising money for our club activities. If you didn't receive any tickets or need more, please see Chuck Montgomery at the membership meeting next Wednesday or call him at 262-968-4190.

The positive financial impact for our club is tremendous if we use this fundraising opportunity to sell just a small number of Alliance tickets. For each \$10 book of tickets we sell, MCW is able to keep \$7.50. So, if all 87 single/family memberships sell the 3 books of tickets they are given, that would generate \$2610 in sales. Our club would keep \$1957.50 of that total to be used for stocking muskies or anything else we decide to support!

In addition to these member ticket sales, our club will be selling Alliance raffle tickets at Mukwonago Maxwell Street Days on June 10-11. We will have the grand prize Ranger boat with us which definitely generates greater interest in Alliance ticket sales. Last year we sold \$2000 worth of raffle tickets when we were there in June. June is expected to have the best attendance and should generate great raffle ticket sales. Imagine the possibilities!

Unfortunately, this event conflicts with the timing of our MCW Spring Outing again this year so many of our members won't be available for the Maxwell Street Days event. It will be important for members not attending the Spring Outing to help this year. As this June weekend approaches, we will be asking for volunteer help to sell these tickets. It is lots of fun to hang out with fellow club members and talk about muskies and our club at these fundraiser events.

ALL Alliance ticket stubs and unsold tickets MUST be returned with the money to Chuck Montgomery by August 10 at the very latest. (We will post reminders as the date approaches.) Chuck is our club's only designated person allowed to turn in our Alliance raffle tickets. He will deliver the ticket stubs and payment to the [National Champion Muskie Open](#) tournament in Eagle River, WI on August 17. Several club members fish in this tournament every year. Maybe this is your year to check it out, too!
