



I enjoy muskie fishing and can be frequently found on Pewankee Lake with club members or fishing in the Musky Open in Eagle River."

Bob and Roxanne built their home in Mae's Walke in 2001. "We were riding Harleys at that time and would bring our Harley friends over to watch the progress. Imagine six or eight Harleys parked weekly, while the bikers walked the lot. The word in the neighborhood was: The Hells Angels are building their clubhouse!

"Some of my favorite memories are of having 20-to-30 bikes start a ride from our driveway - you need to live up to your reputation! We liked Lake Country a lot, but, unlike those who liked the serenity, we wanted a... lot big enough to blast rock and roll music at midnight without disturbing our neighbors. So far, so good."

Since Dale and David were grown before the couple moved in, Bob and Roxanne didn't connect with their neighbors at school events, "but Bob made fast friends by bringing his battery-powered-blender to all subdivision parties and making his famous Blender Bob drinks. In Mae's Walke, we are blessed with neighbors who treat you like family, yet give you room to grow and breathe.




